

Teaching Tips

Activity One

As you introduce a new unit, one of the first competencies is for students to understand what career opportunities are available in that field. Use AGCAREERS.COM as an introduction activity by having students search AGCAREERS.COM to find actual job descriptions and highlight specific requirements or important information. Examples include: Degree Requirements, Salary, and Years of Experience. Students can also use this activity to identify interesting job requirements and responsibilities of an occupation they are eager to explore during the class!

Activity Two

Students can use the AGCAREERS site to compile one page reports about careers in agriculture to share with the class. Information about specific career titles, suggested course work, skills needed and external research areas can all be found on AGCAREERS.COM. Best of all, the jobs are real time, up-to-date accurate career opportunities. Public speaking skills are a must for almost any job in agriculture, what better way to get students speaking in front of the class and preparing for an agricultural career!

Activity Three

Have students use information from AGCAREERS.COM to create classroom posters/bulletin boards about career opportunities in agriculture to educate classes and the school about the wide array of rewarding opportunities in the industry. A great way to recruit students into your classes!
